

WENTY-ONE YEARS AGO, Avery Fisher introduced America's first high fidelity radiophonograph. That instrument attained instant recognition as heralding a new era in the enjoyment of reproduced music. Many features of that early high fidelity radio-phonograph were so basic that they are used to this day in all high fidelity equipment. The engineering achievements of Avery Fisher and the world-wide reputation of his products have been the subject of articles in Fortune, Time, Pageant, The New York Times, Coronet, Life, High Fidelity, Esquire, High Fidelity Trade News, etc.

Benefit concerts for the National Symphony Orchestra in Washington and the Philadelphia Orchestra, demonstrating the great advances in reproducing equipment, used FISHER instruments to play back the recordings that had just been made in the presence of the audience. "Fascinating evening, acoustically and musically," was the Philadelphia Inquirer's comment, "the reproduction had remarkable fidelity." TIME magazine stated, "Listeners could hardly tell the difference between real and electronic."

of 65 watts. Careful design provides full stereophonic channel separation and maximum fidelity. Two, independent three-way speaker systems (total of SIX.)




Slide-out record changer compartment, slide-away front panel door, and magnetic door latch add to the symmetry of the Ambassador's unbroken lines.



AN EXTRAORDINARILY COMPLETE HOME MUSIC CENTER, THE FUTURA II features maximum high fidelity performance in both stereophonic and monaural use, from radio and recordings. Its extremesensitivity FISHER MicroGap Cascode tuner has independent FM and AM channels for the reception of stereophonic broadcasts. Another exclusive FISHER feature is THE FUTURA's two independent MICRORAY Tuning Indicators for FM and AM. The unique advantage of the MICRORAY Tuning Indicator, as it should be, is that its sensitivity is highest on the weakest signal. Accurate tuning is thus almost automatic, even under the most adverse conditions. In addition, wide-band circuitry assures freedom from drift, even on the weakest of FM stations. THE FUTURA's clean, two-channel amplifier delivers up to 40 watts of power in stereo use, and has a reserve of 75 watts for orchestral surges. The STEREOPLEX magnetic cartridge separates channels fully, with no trace of the distortion so frequently encountered in cartridges of lesser quality. THE FUTURA's control center is conveniently arranged and extremely simple to operate, even by an unskilled user.
